## Class of 2023 First Destinations Outcomes

### METHODOLOGY & TERMINOLOGY

Simmons subscribes to the guidelines for undergraduate outcomes data collection and reporting first published by the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) in July, 2019. The Career Education Center surveyed all four graduating baccalaureate cohorts that comprise the Class of 2023: August and October, 2022, and January and May, 2023. The survey period ran up to approximately seven months out from the last of the four cohorts (December 31, 2023). We used the Outcomes Survey tool from Handshake to administer the survey online. We then supplemented the online survey with phone calls, with additional data gathered from the offices of the Registrar and Advancement as well as LinkedIn. We also adopted the NACE terminology, hence "Knowledge Rate" (all data obtained from survey responses and other sources) and "Career Outcomes Rate" (percent engaged either FT or PT, continuing education, volunteering, or in the military).
